

Fishing Heats Up in the Cold

In Minnesota, the fishing stays hot even after the lakes freeze over. Just drill a hole in the ice, (power augers help!), drop in a line and relax until a fish takes a nibble. For many anglers, this low-tech, nofuss, boat-free fishing has a special appeal.

On a beautiful winter day, you can fish out in the open under a vast blue sky. Or, for shelter from the cold and wind, fish from inside a cozy hut. Some



resorts rent ice houses, which range from basic to downright homey with bunks and cook stoves. Resort staff can often provide you with gear and basic instruction, too.

Most of the species caught the rest of the year bite during winter, as well: walleyes, northern pike, yellow perch, sunfish, crappies and, in the wilderness lakes of the northeast, lake trout. January and February are prime time for ice fishing; the ice needs to be thick and strong enough to support anglers and their vehicles.

Check with the DNR for the latest information about ice thickness and safety (mndnr.gov).
