

What is the name of your business? Summit Carbon Solutions Who are your customers? What do you offer/benefits?

Summit's carbon capture infrastructure will allow all our 32 ethanol plant partners to receive a reduction in their carbon intensity score. This process enables the ethanol produced at

these facilities to be sold at a premium in emerging low carbon fuel markets, allowing for higher profits and more robust ethanol industry in Minnesota and the Midwest.

What is something unique or different that you offer that sets you apart?

Once completed, Summit Carbon Solutions' Project will be the world's biggest carbon capture and storage project. This project will be able to capture and permanently store up to 12 million tons of CO2 every year. That's the equivalent of removing 2.6 million vehicles from our roads annually or the same amount of carbon stored by 14 million acres of forest.
